

Admissions Process

APPLICATION FORM AND FEE

1. Please complete the application form and send it to the school along with the appropriate fee: \$60 for U.S. residents and \$120 for international applicants. If the application fee presents a challenge to your family, please contact our office to request a fee waiver, and we will gladly extend one. **Deadline: February 1 for domestic applicants and January 1 for international applicants**.

INTERVIEW

2. During your online interview and virtual tour, you will meet with a member of the admissions committee, explore our building, and get a sense of what sets us apart. Please note that at least one parent/guardian should join you. DAY VISIT

3. After your interview, and once you apply, you will spend a day at Commonwealth—touring the school and attending classes and our daily all-school meeting with a student host. You will also complete two assessments (instead of admission essays you would write on your own) that become part of your application. SUPPORTING MATERIALS

4. Please submit your transcript from your current school. You should request it by giving the transcript release form (included in this application) to your principal or guidance counselor. **Deadline: February** 1.

5. We require three recommendations (included in this application) from your current school: one from a math teacher, one from an English teacher, and one from a head of school, principal, guidance counselor, or placement counselor. **Deadline: February 1.**

6. We strongly encourage students to submit either Secondary School Admissions Test (SSAT) or Independent School Entrance Exam (ISEE) scores, as they provide the admissions committee with a standard metric among applicants. **Deadline: February 1.**

While students who do not submit SSAT or ISEE scores will not be disadvantaged in the application process, we urge you to reach out to us if you have concerns about accessing a test or submitting scores. Students who do not submit SSAT or ISEE results should share the results of any other standardized tests—MCAS, ERB, or MAP—they may have taken during middle school.

Commonwealth's SSAT code is 2542, and our ISEE code is 220222.

Unless they attend a school in which English is the primary language of instruction, international applicants should plan to take the Test Of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) as well.

- 7. Please submit an essay that you have written this school year and that meets the following requirements:
 - It should come from an English, history, or social studies class.
 - It can be either a draft or the final version.
 - While it does not have to be graded, it should include some kind of teacher feedback in the form of a completed rubric, comments, etc.

TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID

We hope that cost will not be a factor as you consider Commonwealth. Since the founding of the school, through a strong commitment to financial aid, we have been dedicated to increasing access to a Commonwealth education and welcoming as many qualified students as possible.

For the 2021-22 academic year:

- Tuition and fees are \$50,483.
- Commonwealth granted over \$1.5 million in financial aid.
- The average financial aid grant is \$34,740.
- Families with financial aid grants paid between \$1,000 and \$48,300 towards the cost of tuition and fees.
- 30% of our students have financial aid grants.
- Commonwealth extended over \$13,000 in additional technology grants. The program includes families whose financial aid grants amount to more than 50% of tuition and fees. Through these dedicated technology grants, they can elect to purchase a MacBook Pro laptop, printer, and software at a reduced cost. On average, participants paid \$320 for this package.
- Commonwealth will offer discounted standardized testing, tutoring support, and public transportation, and will extend additional grants for summer programs and school-sponsored international trips (if conditions allow).

Like many independent schools, Commonwealth employs School and Student Services for Financial Aid (SSS) to assess whether a family is eligible for financial aid and at what level. The SSS formula takes into account a family's income, assets, and debts. To apply for financial aid, families should complete and submit a Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) online at solutionsbysss.com and upload the requested documents by the appropriate deadlines. Please note that Commonwealth's SSS school code is 2542.

Financial Aid Deadlines:

February I - Deadline to complete the PFS and to submit your 2020 federal tax return with all schedules, W-2s, and 1099s.

February 15 - Deadline to submit copies of your 2021 federal tax return with all schedules, W-2s, and 1099s.

March IO - Commonwealth informs families of financial aid decisions along with admission decisions.
